## DREAMER TRAVEL MUG

Paint a travel mug.



## MATERIALS

- Legacy Coupe Dinner Plate SKU (BI158)
  - Toothpicks
    - Q-Tips
    - Sponge
  - Pencil with Eraser
  - Small angle brush

• Paint 62,64,43,67,93,108,18,17,29,11,10,31,61, 15,88

## TIPS

- Allow paint to dry bewteen coats.
  - Wash brush between colors.
- Painting one section at a time/one color at a time and make sure it has enough layers before moving onto the next color.



## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Before you start painting your base coat make sure your bisque/ceramic is dust free, if you find dust on your item, damp a sponge with water and wipe it down (lightly).
- 2. With your large flat angled brush add #62 making a light brush stroke effect onto the mug.
- 3. Let the brush stroke dry.
- 4. With a toothbrush splatter #43, dip brush bristles on paint (watch video for toothbrush technique)
- 5. Repeat same step with #64.
- 6. With a clean large slightly angled brush add #67 to create clouds.
- 7. When creating the clouds, tap the bristles of the brush lightly in circular motions.
- 8. First coat doesn't need to look solid or perfect, let coats dry in between.
- 9. Make sure to add 2 coats.
- 10. Repeat same steps with #93 only painting 1 thick coat, by doing the same circular motions (same as step 7).
- 11. For this step make sure the paint forming the clouds isn't too dry or wet to create swirls within the clouds to give the clouds more definition.
- 12. With the bottom of the same brush start creating swirls within the clouds. Some swirls could be big and small, oval or round in shape.
- 13. Repeat the same swirls patterns on all the clouds. When creating the swirls make sure to go over it twice until you see the color of the ceramic/bisque.
- 14. After paint dries, remove the access paint of the swirls, use a dry clean brush to brush off the paint.
